Beware of scam calls, messages and mails about the special cash payment!

Scam Calls

-  A woman claiming to be from the COVID-19 Task Force calls to ask for the bank account details of the victim in order to process the special cash payment
-  A man calls saying that the special cash payment is ready

Scam mail

-  The government has multiple initiatives to support residents and minimize the damage of COVID-19. You can apply for the 100,000yen special cash payment from: <https://xxxxx.com>

Beware of scammers taking advantage of COVID-19!

- A man visits and demands for 'inspection fees.' He claims to be from the Japan-WHO Association, and says he is checking all the houses in your area due to reports of new COVID-19 cases.
- A man claiming to be from Tokyo Public Health Centre calls asking you to pay for a newly formulated COVID-19 medicine and disinfection of your house.
- Scam cases might increase further in the future.
- If someone asks for handling fees, application fees, your ATM card or your personal information, it's a scam.
- Call the police immediately if you feel suspicious!
