## Restaurant owners, beware of burglary!

Multiple cases of burglary have been reported at restaurants and offices that were closed due to COVID-19. Although shops are no longer asked to close, continue to stay on your guard as crime occurs easily when nobody is around.



### Tips for Crime Prevention

- Don't leave cash or valuables inside your shop after closing
- Lock all doors and windows securely
- Install sensor lights and security cameras

## School Routes Security Cameras Subsidies

Subsidies will be provided to neighbourhood councils for installing security cameras on school routes in order to protect the safety of children. Subsidies differ depending on municipalities, so check with your municipality for more information.

**Eligibility: Municipalities (excl. Designated Cities)**

**Details: The government will cover part of the cost for municipalities subsidising the installation of security cameras for neighbourhood councils**

**Subsidy Amount: 50% of municipal subsidy amount**

**Subsidy Limit: 150,000 yen per camera**

- Residents asked to avoid non-essential outings



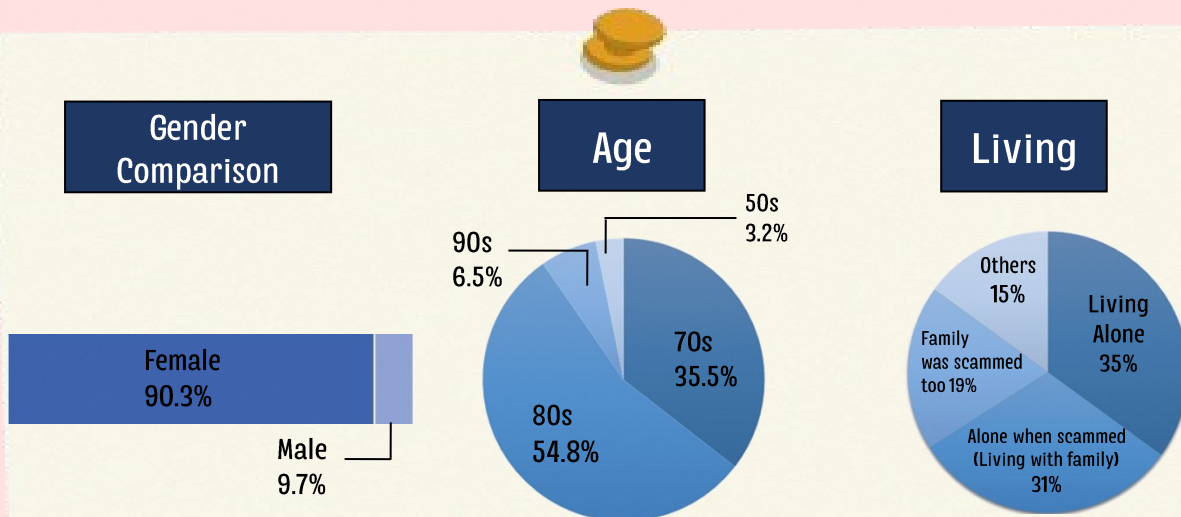
Scammed Victims ↑

### Breakdown of Scam Calls

(As of March 2020, findings by Prefectural Police)



1. Female
2. In their seventies or eighties
3. Alone at home (either living alone or family members absent during scam call)
